



Tear Up The Road!

Grab the wheel and hit the gas! Based on the #1 arcade game, Ivan "Ironman" Stewart's Super Off-Road is an all-out dirt-grinding race. Watch out for the mud holes, jumps and other obstacles on 8 different stadium tracks and 16 configurations. Trade-in cash prizes for racetruck accessories at the Speed Shop and improve your chances for victory. From match-offs to spin-outs, Super Off-Road is as close to genuine short-course racing as you can get.

Main Menu

Controlled by PLAYER-ONE. Press SELECT within eight seconds, or the game will Auto-Play a demonstration game. PRESS START TO BEGIN.

Name Input Menu

Select player names using the A-B, SELECT, or START BUTTONS. When the name is entered, move cursor to FINISH and press any key.

Country Selection Page

Move the colored cursor to the flag of your choice. Press START to select.

Four Player Simultaneous Racing

For the first time ever, four player simultaneous racing is possible on your Nintendo Entertainment System. If you purchase the optional NES Satellite; four controllers can be used at once, allowing up to four players to race simultaneously. Without this interface, you can have only one or two player races.

Use a control pad or joystick to control each racetruck. No matter which controller you choose, maneuvering the racetruck is identical.


During a race, be prepared for anything! The tracks and configurations appear in a specific order. Each track is used in both the clockwise and counterclockwise direction, as indicated by the starting position.

The race ends when one of the players completes four laps and crosses the finish line. This player is the winner.



NOTE: When playing Super Off-Road, there will always be four racetrucks on the track. Any racetruck that is not being driven by a player will Auto-Race.


Using The Control Unit



When your car is stopped, press the A BUTTON. This is your accelerator. It will accelerate your racetruck to its top speed and keep it there until you release the A BUTTON.

Every time you press the B BUTTON, one nitro unit is used. But don't forget to continue to press the accelerator (the A BUTTON) while using a nitro boost.

The Scoreboard



NOTE: Your stats will appear in the box that is the same color as your racetruck.


The Speed Shop

At the Speed Shop, you can purchase accessories with your winnings in order to tune-up your racetruck.

When you start a game, no player has any money, though all players have 3 lives.

If you win a race you gain a life (up to a maximum of 3). If you come in 4th place then you lose a life. If you come in 4th and lose your *last* life you will be asked, after the Awards Screen, if you want to continue racing or retire. If you elect to retire then you are out of the game. If you continue, then your racetruck will retain any accessories that were bought for it. You will be given 3 more lives but you lose all cash and points.

Note: After race #20 you will not be allowed to restart once all your lives are gone.



The game is in two sections, the Qualification rounds and the Tournament. The Qualification rounds are the first 14 races, and gives each player a chance to buy accessories before the Tournament. The Tournament starts at race No. 15. If a player loses all of his lives in the Tournament, he will not be allowed to continue playing.

There are 5 accessories you can buy for your racetruck:

NITRO FUEL UNITS	\$10,000 EACH (UP TO 99)
	\$40,000 EACH (UP TO 6)
SHOCKS	\$60,000 EACH (UP TO 6)
ACCELERATION	\$80,000 EACH (UP TO 6)
TOP SPEED	\$100,000 EACH (UP TO 6)

If you try to buy an item you cannot afford, you will enter the "Wait To Race" mode.

Nitro fuel will give you an extra boost of speed over your normal top speed. By buying better tires, you can increase the grip on the ground and decrease the amount of skid. By buying more shocks accessories, the car will bounce less, allowing you to take tighter corners at higher speeds.

The Top Speed accessory will noticeably increase the normal driving speed of your racetruck. By buying the Acceleration accessory, your racetruck will accelerate to its top speed more quickly. The Speed Shop contains 4 menus, one for each racer. Each menu displays the racer's accumulated money, remaining lives, the 5 accessories, and the next track. To buy an accessory, move the cursor over your choice, then press SELECT. When you're done buying accessories, move the cursor over NEXT RACE and press SELECT. The race will begin.

Two Ways To Win!

With Super Off-Road, you can win prize money two ways: track bonuses and final position.

Track Bonuses

To win extra money, try to hit the bonus targets on the track with your racetruck. Bonuses range from \$10,000 to \$40,000.

Nitro canisters can also be collected and start as 1 extra and increase up to 5 extra.

Final Position

You also receive winnings for your racetruck's position at the end of the race.


WINNINGS

1ST PLACE — \$150,000 2ND PLACE — \$130,000 3RD PLACE — \$110,000 4TH PLACE — \$100,000 At the end of a race, each player is awarded points that are separate from the cash score. You receive (1) point for every \$1,000 dollars that you win during a race. Points accumulate as races are played and are entered on the High Score Table when the game is over.

Any player beaten by a computer controlled racetruck will have their winnings reduced by \$30,000.

Hot Tips!

· Get ahead of the pack! At the start of a race, use nitro boosts to move in front of the other drivers.



· Watch for collisions! If you're not careful. your racetruck will crash into a barrier or another car and be destroyed.


. Buy as much nitro fuel as you can! If you use your nitro boosts correctly, you can multiply your speed by as much as 3 times.




